

Case Study: Clinton School District

Background

Altogether, the three schools within Clinton School District in Clinton, AR, feed 1,420 students at two separate cafeterias each day.

The Challenge

A lack of communication among Clinton SD's sites was causing problems for the overall School Nutrition program. Tammy Allen, the district's Food Service Secretary for the past 10 years, says that her sites were isolated, so when one cafeteria would change a process or do something different, it would affect the other sites as well as the overall program.

Complicating the matter, Tammy was hesitant to switch to a new system because, as she put it, "I've heard horror stories of people not having good tech support. They have the software, but they can't do much with it."
